Notice of Closure – Wollongong Tennis Club

Dear Members, Friends and Supporters of Wollongong Tennis Club,

It is with deep regret and sincere sadness that we write to advise our members, guests, sporting partners and the wider Wollongong community that the Wollongong Tennis Club will unfortunately be closing its premises due to ongoing financial hardship.

This decision has not been made lightly. The Club has faced sustained financial pressure over a number of years, including continuing operating losses, reduced cash flow, increasing costs and uncertainty regarding the long-term future of the Club's premises. The clubs recent financial reports show significant losses, negative operating cash flow, and a material uncertainty regarding the Club's ability to continue as a going concern. These matters have made it no longer viable for the Club to continue trading in its current form.

For many years, Wollongong Tennis Club has been proud to provide tennis, hospitality, social connection and community facilities to members, families, players, volunteers and local residents. The Club has been more than a sporting venue; it has been a place where friendships have been formed, competitions have been played, community events have been held and generations of people have shared their love of tennis.

We acknowledge that this news will be disappointing and upsetting for many people. The Board of Directors extend our heartfelt thanks to every member, employee, volunteer, coach, sponsor, supplier, visitors and community supporters who have contributed to the Club's history and spirit. Your loyalty and commitment have meant a great deal, particularly during the difficult periods the Club has experienced in recent years.

The Clubs final day of trade will be Saturday, 29th August 2026.

A final drinks event will be held prior to the closure, with more information to come; bookings will be essential.

We will endeavour to manage this process respectfully, transparently and with care for all affected members, staff and stakeholders.

On behalf of Wollongong Tennis Club, thank you for your support, friendship and contribution over the years. While this is an extremely difficult chapter, we remain grateful for the role the Club has played in the Wollongong community and for the people who have made it so special.
